Covid

The CDC has not changed daycares guidelines as of yet.

So parents and children still need to quarantine for ten days. In the scenario that it is a parent that is exposed or sick, they will need to get tested or quarantine for their ten days, and then either wait 2-3 days and test the child OR have the child quarantine for their ten days before returning to care. If it is the child who is exposed, they will need to either get tested in a timely manner or quarantine for 10 days. We know that the time frame is frustrating and hard on families, but this is the requirement we are given by the CDC and state as a licensed childcare.
