Schedule Changes

Due to the pandemic, parents' schedules have changed. In an effort to fit all the children's needs into our hours of operation, we have changed our daily routine:

- **9:00 am** **Breakfast/AM Snack (grain, fruit and milk)**
- **9:30 am** **Outdoor play time (dependent on number of infants and staffing)**
- **10:45 am** **Calm down time before lunch**
- **11:15 am** **Lunch**
- **11:35 am** **First child gets laid down (time approximate)**
- **12:15-12:30** **All children laid down & quiet time for older children**
- **2:30/3:00** **PM Snack (when children start to wake up)**
- **4:15 pm** **Outside time (if it isn't too hot or humid and if daycare is picked up)**

This new schedule has worked well with the children and helps staff fit everything in with infant nap times. But please remember, childcare schedules don't always work as planned. Variations in nap times and outside weather conditions can affect play time. We do try to get the kids outside as much as possible so please be patient with us.

COVID-19

With COVID-19 cases on the rise, we continue to do all we can at ABC Huskies Child Care to provide a safe and healthy environment for your child. Toys are disinfected twice a day, anything that goes in the mouth is re-sanitized, and often-touched surfaces are disinfected as needed.

On the sign-in sheet, parents are asked at pick-up and drop-off time if children have come into contact with COVID-19 and/or have symptoms. This is all mandatory per the state's request. If you have come into contact with COVID-19, you are to quarantine for 14 days and if your child has been to daycare after coming into contact, you must notify us. This makes it possible for other parents to decide what their next move will be and if they should be around certain family members. We care for children who have high risk people in their families and some that are high risk themselves. Out of respect for other families, it is important you let us know of any contact with a positive COVID-19 case. If you are found to have been in contact with COVID-19 and choose not to notify ABC Huskies, you could lose your childcare spot during this health crisis. We can't keep a stable group without everyone putting forth their effort in keeping all the children safe and healthy.
