Covid/Illness

Complaints

Hear say can help form policies but staff cannot be reprimanded or corrected without the parent coming directly to Mika herself.

Holidays

We will be closed for Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's. We are open for Black Friday, Christmas eve, and New Year's Eve as needed. Please make sure to let Mika know if you will be needing care and the exact time needed so she can make sure to have the proper number of staff scheduled. If no children are scheduled for these days, we will remain closed.

Wet/Cold Weather

It is officially fall/winter weather! Please remember to dress the children according to the weather. If they have outgrown last year hat and gloves, please trade out their supplies here for a new set. Also make sure their spare clothes are still the appropriate size and suiting for the colder temperatures.

Rainboots

We are trying to get as much outside time as possible even in the colder weather. But when it is wet or muddy outside that hinders our outside time. If the children have rainboots that are left at daycare all would be able to play outside no matter the state of the playground. We are asking that parents supply a pair of rainboots or boots that can be wiped clean easily to be left at daycare for each child. If acquiring a pair of rainboots isn't feasible please reach out to Mika and we may be able to find other accommodations for your child/ren.
